Thank you for your trust in me to serve as your WINGA Treasurer in 2018. The fiscal condition of the Association continues to be sound. Attached you will find the WINGA "Profit and Loss Statement" for 2018.

The Association continues to support many programs and services which enhance and promote our members, their families and the Wisconsin National Guard. A few noteworthy activities in 2018 include:

- \$85,000 was approved to support the F-35 initiative for the 115th Fighter Wing.
- Awarded seven (7) \$500 scholarships to dependents of WINGA members totaling \$3,500.
- Recognized three (3) outstanding Company Grade Officers; CPT Phillip Southworth, Lt Cedar Hamilton and CW2 Scott Kramer.
- Contributed \$2,000 to Northern Lightning Exercise.
- Awarded \$1,000 in grants to MSC/Wings.
- Provided \$750 in funding to support the Commissioned Officer Summit.
- Provided \$250 in funding to support the Warrant Officer Summit.
- Provided \$2,000 for the TAG Contingency Fund.
- Sponsored five (5) CGO's attending Professional Development at NGAUS Conference.
- Financially supported Incentive Life Membership Program for NGAUS for \$18,500.
- Sponsored attendees for the NGAUS Industry and Legislative Days in DC.
- Sponsored awardee plaques for Army Guard HOF and Air Guard HOH for \$1,447.
