

An Intro & Guide to NGAUS Resolutions

What is a resolution? A resolution is the first part in suggesting a change in the law or an addition. Those with an active NGAUS membership can submit a change to the law through the resolutions process. Once the suggested change is accepted and approved by the Wisconsin National Guard Association, Inc. (WINGA), then the request goes to the National Guard Association of the United States (NGAUS) annual conference.

Before you submit a resolution, please check the NGAUS website [<http://www.ngaus.org/>] to see if there is a standing (pre-existing) resolution.

If you don't have your login you can still read the **standing resolutions** for Army, Air and Joint.



Click the drop down for legislation and then resolutions.
