SUBJECT: Annual Report of the Company Grade Officer (CGO) Advisory Committee

1. Per your guidance the priorities and purpose of the CGO Advisory Committee are to solicit input, measure success, and ensure our community of CGOs have a viable voice in the future of our organization. This venue provides insight and ideas to the WINGA Board of Directors on issues and provides recommendations from the tactical level of the Wisconsin National Guard.
2. This committee assists WINGA's Strategic Plan Core Strategy #2, Provide Effective Communication To Members And Partners, specifically Goal #2 Increase Member Engagement and Awareness. Our CGOs are the future leadership of the WING; their ability to recognize and embrace the value-add by being engaged will enhance the future of WINGA and NGAUS.
3. The CGO Advisory Committee had three committee meetings during calendar year 2019. We addressed professional development opportunities, the selection of WINGA sponsored scholarships to events, WINGA/NGAUS Conferences, and how WINGA and WNGEA membership and benefits are communicated to units, among other topics.
4. WINGA had four (4) applicants (2 Army, 1 WO, and 1 AF) for scholarships to the NGAUS Convention in Denver. Each received a full ride scholarship from WINGA to attend. Overall there were 14 CGOs in Denver.
5. The CGO Advisory Committee currently consists of 11 Service Members; eight (8) Army and three (3) Air Force. I want to thank Capt. Joshua Johnson for his time and effort over the past four years to ensure this committee achieves its goals and objectives and to the rest of the committee for sharing their perspectives and unfiltered opinions. We look forward to our continued support in ensuring a broader understanding of WINGA and increased participation from all ranks.
