Thank you for your trust in me to serve as your WINGA Treasurer in 2019. The fiscal condition of the Association continues to be sound. Attached you will find the WINGA "Profit and Loss Statement" for 2019.

The Association continues to support many programs and services which enhance and promote our members, their families and the Wisconsin National Guard. A few noteworthy activities in 2019 include:

- Awarded seven (10) \$500 scholarships to dependents of WINGA members totaling \$5,000.
- Recognized three (3) outstanding Company Grade Officers; CPT Cody Anderson, Lt Jenna Lenski and CW2 Lucas Marks.
- Contributed \$1,500 to Northern Lightening Exercise.
- Awarded \$500 in grants to MSC/Wings.
- Rebates of \$999.75 to 100% NGAUS/WINGA membership units.
- Provided \$173 in funding to support the Warrant Officer Summit.
- Provided \$2,000 for the TAG Contingency Fund.
- Sponsored four (4) CGO's attending Professional Development at NGAUS Conference.
- Sponsored two (2) NGAUS awardees attendance at conference.
- Financially supported Incentive Life Membership Program for NGAUS for \$14,250.
- Sponsored attendee to attend the NGAUS Legislative Days in DC.
- Sponsored awardee plaques for Army Guard HOF and Air Guard HOH for \$1,447.
- Operational grants to WNGEA totaling \$41,000.
