SUBJECT: Awards, Gifts and Grants (AG&G) Committee Annual Report 2021

- 1. The purpose of the AG&G Committee is to recognize individuals and organizations that, by superior performance or service of a meritorious nature, make a contribution to the goals of this association and the effectiveness of the Wisconsin National Guard. The program was established in 1978 and has evolved to support superior performance, leadership and causes, which benefit the WINGA membership and the educational scholarships for members and dependents.
