MEMORANDUM FOR WINGA MEMBERSHIP

SUBJECT: 2022 Finance Committee Report

1. The WINGA Finance Committee, composed of members of the Executive Committee (EXCOM), developed the proposed 2021 WINGA, Inc. budget and presented it to the WINGA Board of Directors. For 2021, a proposed budget reflecting \$171,776 in expenditures and \$171,800 of revenue was unanimously approved. Committee members focused on controlling expenses with a balanced budget while also focusing on building the organization. Actual expenses for 2021 totaled \$189,873 (+18,097) and revenue totaled \$174,523 (+2,723) resulting in an additional \$15,374 executed in support of the organization. Board decisions to support the Wisconsin National Guard Foundation start up (\$5,000) coupled with approved increases in contract services and personnel services accounted for the increased expenditures.
2. Supporting our WINGA members and their families is a top priority for our Association leadership. To demonstrate the organizations commitment, WINGA was able to financially support ten \$1,000 college scholarships, MSC/Wing grants, support to the Wisconsin National Guard Enlisted Association, \$5,000 to start the Wisconsin National Guard Foundation, and over \$1,500 in plaques for Hall of Honor and Hall of Fame. Investments in professional development speakers during the WINGA/WNGEA annual conference continue to be made increasing the value of this keystone event.
3. Growing membership in NGAUS further strengthens the organizations political influence and elevates National Guard issues to the forefront. In order to increase maintain a strong and supportive organization, WINGA continued the support the NGAUS Life Membership Incentive Program. This program continues to benefit both the member and the organization. In addition, the "41 or Bust" program awarded additional awarded lifetime WINGA/NGAUS memberships.
4. As Chairman of the Finance Committee, I am pleased with the amount of financial support WINGA was able to give back to our membership, the support the commands, and further the WI National Guard mission. A commitment of giving back to membership and increasing WINGA involvement continues to be the theme. In the coming year, WINGA will discuss other request for financial support through the Wing/MSC representatives that will support membership objectives.
